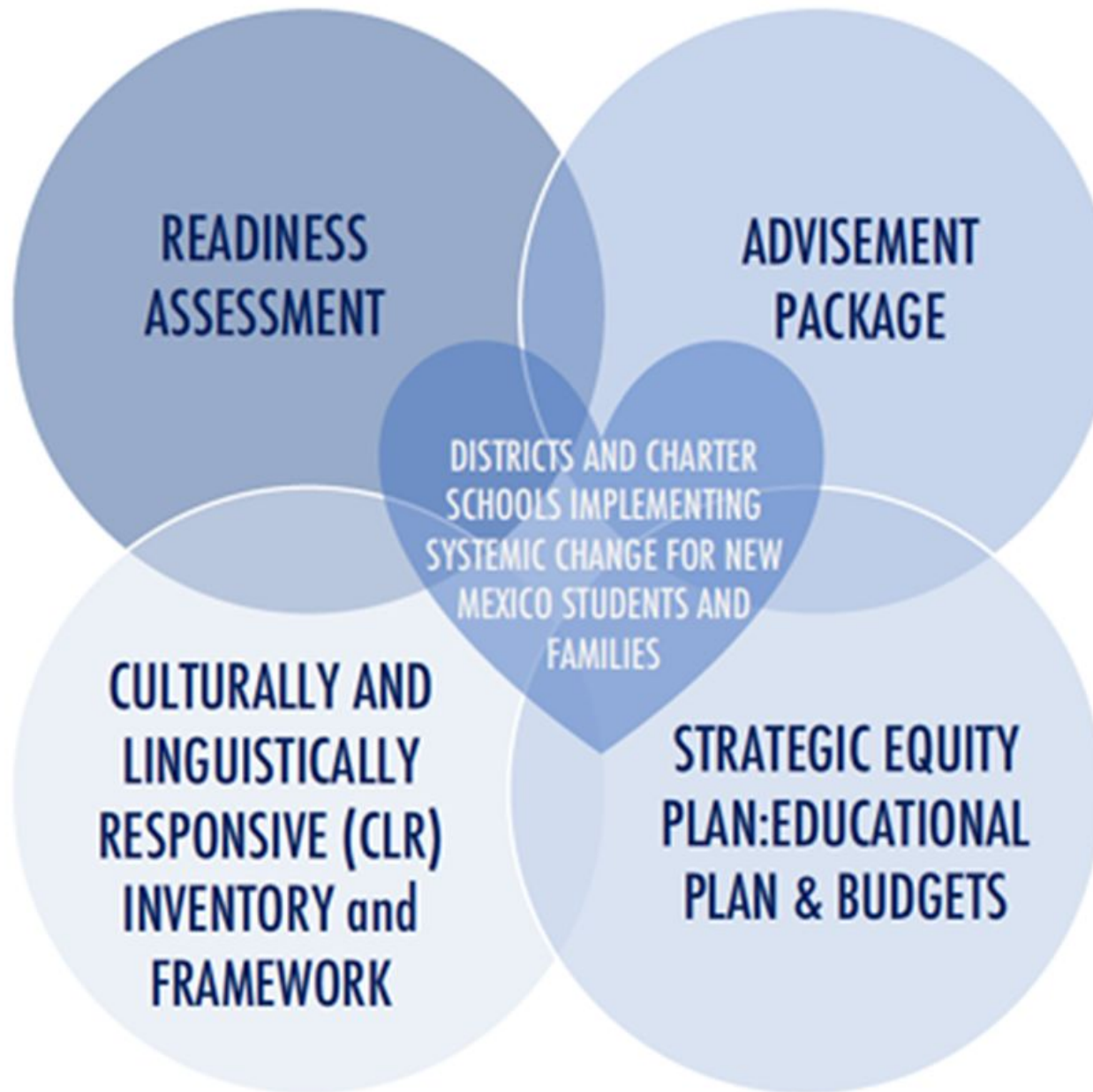


Regional Launches

- That serve **159,824** students

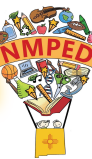
