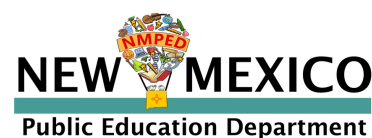




21ST CCLC PROGRAM

PRIMARY GOALS

SCHOOL YEAR 2022-26



New Mexico 21st Century Community Learning Centers' (CCLC) selected statewide student outcomes and performance measures at each community learning center.

1. **Maintain and improve student academic achievement in language arts and math.**
 - Of students earning a passing grade after the first grading period, 75 percent will maintain a passing grade by the close of the academic year.
 - Of students earning below a passing grade after the first grading period, 50 percent will raise their grades by the close of the academic year.
2. **Design and deliver a 21st CCLC program to meet the needs of all constituent groups.**
 - Of all survey participants, 85 percent will agree or strongly agree that the 21st CCLC program offered in their community is high quality.
3. **Implement a program that engages students.**
 - The program will meet 75 percent of the target enrollment goal each academic year.
 - The program will maintain an average attendance rate of 75 percent throughout the academic year for enrolled classes.
